Scouts and Scouters of Troop 205 – we have planned a very exciting and memorable experience to live like a soldier at Fort Ticonderoga, NY! Here are the details:

<b>Leaving:</b>	Friday, October 27, 2023 <u><a href="#">promptly at 5:00 PM</a></u> , from the Great River Fire House. Please arrive no later than 4:45 PM to pack the vehicles.
<b>Returning:</b>	Late afternoon on Sunday, October 29, 2023.
<b>Itinerary:</b>	<p><b><u>Friday</u></b> – Arrival at Fort Ticonderoga and setting up camp in the main parade grounds within Fort Ticonderoga. We will be camping within the fort itself.</p> <p><b><u>Saturday</u></b> – <b>0800-0900 Reveille and Flag Raising.</b> 18<sup>th</sup> Century breakfast to follow. <b>0900-1300 Scout Self Directed Activities.</b></p> <p><b>1300-1430 Self-Guided exploration of Fort Ticonderoga.</b> Visit the museum exhibits, visit the historic trade shops. Take part in general guided tours and demonstrations.</p> <p><b>1430-1530 Planting of the Tree Liberty Program.</b> Become immersed in the daily routine of the soldiers garrisoning Fort Ticonderoga in the weeks after the capture of the fort by Ethan Allen and Benedict Arnold in 1775. Form a platoon of soldiers and practice teamwork and discipline as you undergo a typical day in the life of soldiers.</p> <p><b>1530-1600 Soldiers' Fatigue.</b> Explore tasks from a typical day in the life of Continental soldiers garrisoning Fort Ticonderoga 1775-1777, including cutting firewood, logging, building earthen fortifications, and more.</p> <p><b>1600-1700</b> Load gear on ox sleds.</p> <p><b>1700 hrs Guided Hike of Fort Ticonderoga</b></p> <p><b>1830-1930 Flag Lowering</b></p> <p><b>1830-2000 18<sup>th</sup> Century Dinner.</b></p> <p><b>2000 hrs Scouting activities and campfire with cracker barrel.</b></p> <p><b><u>Sunday</u></b> – Breakdown camp and prepare for return home. Breakfast will consist of muffins, donuts, and Danishes for the ride home.</p>
<b>Cost:</b>	\$130 to \$185 based on number of participants. (Sat lunch/Sun breakfast included). Credits made to the Scout Accounts, if any.
<b>Dress:</b>	100% conformance to the following dress policy is needed: Class "A" Uniform for Friday and Saturday evening. Class "B" or Class "C" for Saturday and Sunday.
<b>Packing:</b>	Sack lunch for Sat, uniforms as stated above, sleeping bag, day pack (to hold lunch, water bottle, and rain poncho) rain poncho, good hiking shoes or boots, sweatshirt or fall weather type jacket. <b>Best behavior and Scout Spirit!!!</b>
<b>Cell Phones:</b>	<b>Troop policy – Cell Phones allowed for travel and collected and nonoperational during the Ft. stay.</b>
