Buses will be provided from Southaven to the Carnival the entire time the Carnival is open.

Saturday 5/4 Activities:

Aquatic Area: Canoes and kayaks. You will have the opportunity to get out on the water and enjoy the Carmens River.

Boy Scout and Venturing Activities: Archery Shooting, Tomahawk Throwing, BMX Bike Trails, Monkey Bridges, Pioneering, Caving and Orienteering are only a few of the activities that await the Scouts.

- Leaving:** Friday, May 3, 2019 - 5:30pm from the Great River Fire Department. Meet at 5:00pm.
- Itinerary:** Arrive Friday evening to set up Camp & attend the carnival. Participate in the camporee events all day Saturday. Attend the Big Show Saturday night. All meals covered by the Camporee. There is also a trading post for souvenirs and a concession stand for snacks.
Shotgun shooting will be available for an extra fee of \$25.00 for Scouts of 13 years old and older. *The Shotgun program is limited to 160 participants, council-wide, on a first-come, first-served basis. Pre-registration is a must. We expect this to fill up fast, so make your reservations for the shotgun program as soon as possible.*
- Returning:** Home Sunday. Arrive approximately 12:00 noon.
- Cost:** Overnight camper fees includes all meals Saturday and breakfast on Sunday.
Camporee fee if paid by April 18th - \$55 per person. If paid after April 18th - \$65 per person.
For units camping for the weekend there will be no need to bring any cooking equipment. This will be handled just like if you were going to the National Jamboree. Breakfast on Saturday, dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday will all be picked up by the unit at the commissary. No cooking or food preparation will be required. For Saturday Lunch each participant will get a voucher for lunch at the concession stand.
- Dress/Packing:** Class "A" Uniform for Friday and the return trip on Sunday. Class "B" Uniform for Saturday, Class "A" for Saturday night and Sunday. Bring sleeping bag, camp chair, day pack for Saturday and **pack to walk-in to campsite**.
- Troop policy:** **No Scouts bring Cell Phones.** Leaders will have cell phones if any calls are necessary.
- Sign up:** Bring signed permission form and appropriate Camporee fee plus additional \$25 for shotgun (if age eligible and interested) on or before April 16th meeting – paying later increases your cost.
