

EAGLE BOOK COMPONENTS

For your upcoming Scoutmaster's Conference, after the completion of your last merit badge, you will want to compile your Eagle Book, consisting of the following:

1. Cover page, including the following:

- A. Eagle Badge Metal or Patch visual,
- B. Your Name: _____
- C. Troop number: 205
- D. Troop town: Great River, NY
- D. Sagtikos District

2. Completed Eagle Scout Application, as downloaded as a fillable .PFD off the Eagle section of the Troop site. Please be sure to include the complete information on all your references, and for the merit badge listings, please get an Internet Advancement report emailed from Mr. Bernichon to match up the earned merit badges dates. For the required merit badges where there is a choice of merit badges, be sure to strike through the merit badge(s) that you did not earn.

3. Purpose of Life Essay - one to two pages typed, covering how Scouting and earning the Eagle Scout Badge has prepared you for your future schooling, career, and life. I would also talk about your future educational, career, and family life aspirations.

4. Scouting experiences, awards, and honors - A separate page, in bullet page format, covering your most memorable Scouting experiences (i.e. Summer Camp, Campouts, High Adventure, Jamborees, etc.), awards, honors, leadership positions, etc.

5. School and community awards, honors, and accomplishments you are proud of, in bullet point format, covering school items like GPA, Honor Rolls, Sports, clubs, music, organizations, and awards, in addition to awards and recognitions from the community.

6. Your completed Eagle Project Book (Pre, during, and post Project sections), including all the sign offs and fundraising application approved.

For your Scoutmaster's Conference, you will just need your original completed Eagle Book, complete with a slim three ring binder booklet, featuring a clear cover and most have a solid color back page cover, with three hole punch.

After your Eagle Book has been reviewed and approved at your Scoutmaster's Conference you will need to have the following:

- A. Your Original Eagle Book for submission to the Council Office, along with one complete copy, also bound like the original. Please take these two items to the Suffolk County Council Service Center, during normal Monday through Friday office hours (not the Scout Shop retail store hours) at: 1 Independence Hill, Suite 202, Farmingville, NY 11738. You may confirm the office hours by calling 631-924-7000,
- B. Five additional copies of your complete Eagle Books, like the copy as described above, that will be used for your Eagle Board of Review, and
- C. One additional copy - the same as described above, for you.

Please review your Eagle Book with your Eagle Advisor/Coach, prior to your Scoutmaster's Conference. At least one parent, with the option of your Eagle Advisor/Coach should accompany you at your Eagle Scoutmaster's Conference.
